Dear Residents, Family and Friends,

I must notify everyone that a resident in the building has tested positive for COVID-19 yesterday. This is a vaccinated individual and the vaccines seem to be doing what they were developed to do. Remember that we are being told that vaccinated individuals can still carry and spread the virus, this is why we all need to be extra careful. This will restart our 14-day clock regarding suspension of communal meals and activities. I must also insist that all residents avoid utilizing any of the common areas of the building for the same 14 days. If you are outside of your apartment, remember you need a mask that is worn properly over your nose and mouth, if you do not have one we will provide one.

We need to stop the spread so we ask that you avoid any face to face contact with other residents for this next 14 days. If face to face contact is necessary please make sure to social distance and wear your masks. Please also avoid having other residents in your home or apartment. Please consider rescheduling any unnecessary visits you have with family and friends until at least the 14 days has passed.

To help in trying to reduce the risk of internal transmission we are going to suspend housekeeping services temporarily and look at resuming them on Tuesday September 7<sup>th</sup> 2021.

Let us know if you are experiencing any signs or symptoms as we can assist in consulting your physician for their recommendations. If you are experiencing them please do not come to the desk but rather call and we will help decide the best course of action.

Please remind any and all visitors you have coming that a mask is required 100% of the time when on Parkwood property. I strongly recommend you practice social distancing in all situations until such time we are able to start resuming communal programs.

For the health and wellbeing of yourself, your family, the residents, your team members, and the community, continue to follow all recommended guidelines to avoid the transmission of COVID-19 so that we can all get back to a normal life.
